

## August Liturgy Report 2018

The Liturgy Committee guidelines outlined by the Archdiocese were briefly reviewed.

Jim discussed the potential schedule for weekend Masses in town when only one active priest is available. Monsignor Bleich and Monsignor Wilgenbusch will each be covering a weekend this Fall and they are traveling from Dubuque. Also, this Advent and Lent, we may just have one Communal Reconciliation at each parish.

Eucharistic Adoration – Two new committee members have been added. Sign-up Sunday will take place September 8 and 9. Cyndi inquired about 'Text Alerts' for Eucharist Adoration suspensions and Mass schedule changes. Bob will look into this.
