Meeting Prayer --- ON BACK

Fr. Don updates – commented on the return of instrumentalists at Mass. Discussed the Friday night schedule for Lent.

Anointing of the Sick will be rescheduled at a later date.

No report from Eucharistic Adoration Committee

This summer, we would like parishioners to volunteer weekly to decorate the altar area.

Holy Week - Discussed the Archdiocesan Guidelines for Holy Week that were given in January. In February, the Archbishop updated these guidelines in an email to the priests.

Passion Sunday – Do not distribute palms in any way as long as the pandemic is in play.

Holy Thursday - April 1 at 7:30pm - Archdiocese recommends that the washing of feet is not staged.

Good Friday – April 2 at 7pm – Do not present the Cross for a veneration that involves touching or kissing it as long as the pandemic is in play. From the Archbishop - For the Veneration of the Cross, it is recommended to use the First Form (which does not involve a procession). For the Adoration of the Holy Cross, see rubric no. 19, which allows for the people to venerate from their pews, in silence.

Easter Vigil – April 3 at 8pm - There will be no Blessing of Fire. Liturgy will begin with the Blessing of the Candle with the Exultet to follow. As long as the pandemic is in play, precaution should take place when administering the anointing of oil.

Easter Sunday – April 4 at 8:30am, 10:30am, and 5pm in Spanish. There will be no 7am Easter Sunday Mass this year.
